

Bible Motto verse: Proverbs 3:5-6

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

WHY:

We have a wonderful church building that is now over 150 years old. While we greatly appreciate the beauty of the historic church building, we are aware that there are some aspects of it which make it less than ideal for ministry in the 21st Century.

Some find it cold, uncomfortable, formidable, and unapproachable. While disabled people can enter the church building, there are no appropriate toilet facilities and the chancel, alter rail and vestry area are not accessible to those in wheelchairs.

The audio-visual system requires updating to improve accessibility to all parts of the service, particularly improving the sound quality and enhancing the experience for those who are hard of hearing.

The music group is currently set in a corner out of direct sight of a large part of the congregation, which is not ideal in enabling them to lead effective worship.

The current entrance is welcoming but the side door is difficult to find for those who are new to the church.

The project has been driven by a desire to honour God, provide a welcoming church that meets the needs of ministry in 21st Century, is accessible to all and enables more people to come to know Jesus as their personal saviour.

The church community has been discussing the layout of the church interior building for a number of years, with the plans evolving and adapting over time.

The current project arose out of the **PCC/Ministry Team Vision Day** in September 2019. On that day we looked at prayer/worship, sharing LYFE together and Mission.

We believe that the proposed changes to the church building are in line with the aims which arose from the discussions that day.

We very much desire that Christ Church's building be a place that...

- * Is welcoming to all
- * Facilitates our worship of God and meeting with Him.
- * Encourages the development of fellowship
- * Is flexible, allowing it to be used seven days a week

Planned Improvements

- * Comfort underfloor heating and comfortable seating
- * Accessibility particularly to chancel and vestry, disabled toilet
- * Hospitality a new kitchen area
- * Layout better visibility for worship leaders
- * Room development to allow more flexible building use

Advice from church leaders that have been involved in similar projects


Visits to other churches that have reordered their interior.

- * Estimates from three building firms with appropriate experience
- * Further consultation with PCC
- * Submission of plans for consideration/ approval by Faculty to Diocesan Advisory Committee

Particular features of Plans

PHASE 1 - WEST END

- * Glass doors entrance light, and welcoming
- * Straight entrance disability friendly
- * Opening up the church glass doors focusing on heat preservation, with clear view into church interior
- * Underfloor heating to the back of the church
- * New accessible disabled toilet
- * New kitchen area in current library corner with section of lower counter enabling wheelchair and children access and space for cold drinks.
- * Wide counter enables cupboard space to be provided on both sides.
- * Chairs rather than pews in back area to allow greater flexibility with use of space with includes provision for different/variety of users/uses during the week

PHASE 2 - EAST END


* Underfloor heating throughout - radiant heating effectively heats to 2 metres, with constant lower-level background heating.


- * Ramp to run along north wall to enable disabled access to "choir room / vestry" area and via these to chancel area
- * Enlarge/redesign of chancel area to provide flexibility in the layout of the worship space – allowing the Music group/organ to be re-sited to an enlarged chancel area – enabling more effective/inclusive worship
- * Replacement of some or all of pews with stackable chairs - up to 40 at a time can be stored under the window in the current music corner
- * Replacement of gas boiler
- * Redesign vestry/organ loft area to provide enclosed areas/rooms that can be used for Diddy Disciples, group meetings, or small services

FINANCES

- * Phased project
- * Significant finance already available due to legacies and giving expected to cover much if not all of Phase 1 of project
- * Application for grants
